

We know of at least 15 of our churches which took part in this effort. I would like to thank all of those who contributed in any way, and to give special thanks to **Bill and Cindy Gore** and **Phil Thomas** for pulling our two trailer loads of backpacks up to Macon. A total of over 14,000 backpacks for the children of Appalachia were received from all over our state at the Macon meeting!
