Missionary Musings

2015 is right around the corner, and with it the possibilities and opportunities afforded by a New Year. In the Bethel Baptist Association, I know of at least three new and/or special things that will be happening in 2015:

- 1. February 8-15 we will observe our first **BBA Associational Missions Emphasis and Special Offering** to supplement the regular contributions from our churches and to support and advance our own local missions activities. Our offering goal for this first year is \$5,000.
- 2. Our experiment with a new, **Sunday evening format for our annual Associational Meetings** begins with our Spring Meeting on March 29th (Palm Sunday) at Shiloh Baptist Church, at 5PM.
- 3. We will have a **world missions conference**, dubbed our "On Mission Connection," on the weekend of September 12-13, with international, North American, and state missionaries sharing their missions experiences in our churches. In addition to these opportunities, I am also excited by the growing interest in **BCM** (Baptist Campus Ministry) work at our **Bainbridge College/Early County Campus**. We had a great strategy meeting with some of our local BBA leaders and school faculty and administration and the foundation seems to be in place for launching some sort of Bible study/discipleship group on campus this semester. During recent final exams week at the college, several of our volunteers served refreshments for students, and over 30 students indicated an interest in participating in the new campus ministry! We will be needing church groups to help us in the coming days with food, etc. for these on-campus ministries.
