First of all, I want to express my gratitude for the many cards, phone calls, emails and textmessages which I received expressing your condolences to our family in the loss of my brother, Ken, just after Thanksgiving. We are rejoicing in the blessings of our "Christmas Backpacks" ministry in 2018. As of this writing, we have distributed nearly 1,800 backpacks filled with Christmas goodies and the Gospel message to children in our six-county area! And most important, we have been able share the Gospel to with hundreds of parents and other along with these adults, children. So far, we know of 64 decisions for Christ that were made at our December Backpack distribution events! statistics from all of our events to date:

-Baker county (Newton): We gave out 134 backpacks -Cahhoun county (Edison): 240 backpacks -Clay County (Fort Gaines): 240 backpacks -Early county (Blakely, Cedar Springs, New Zion BC, and Springfield BC): 530 -Quitman County (Georgetown): 225 -Randolph county (Cuthbert): 429 Total: 1,798

Praise the Lord for all of the Georgia Baptists churches and associations that sent us Christmas Backpacks, and for the dozens of volunteers who helped to make these distribution events such wonderful Birthday Parties for Jesus+!

And now we stand on the threshold of another New Year. We have already made a fresh commitment for 2019 toward doing all that we can to facilitate church revitalization and reaching the next generation through the Bethel Baptist Association. I pray that you will join hands and hearts with us as we step forward on this great adventure.
