We are excited about these guest evangelists, and will be putting out some special promotional materials on both events over the next couple of weeks. Please mark the dates on your calendars, pray **specifically** for the lost to be drawn to these events and saved by the Spirit of God, and for all of the details and "logistics" to fall into place. Our desire is for God to be honored and His Kingdom extended through these meetings. Plan now to be a part of it all!
