


Executive Committee Meeting on Monday, June 22 at Arlington Baptist Church, 7 pm

I pray that, as our local churches begin "re-opening" for public worship services, I will be able to personally visit with many of you over the next four months. I look forward to seeing you face-to-face and being able to tell you all how much we love and appreciate you, and to encourage you to remain faithful to our Lord Jesus Christ and to His mission.
