We had a wonderful time at our Spring Inspirational Meeting at ShellIman First Baptist Church on April 10th. There were over 100 people in attendance, representing 20 different churches. We took up \$423 for our BBA missions offering, bringing our total for the 2016 offering to \$2,301.

Our speaker, Bro. Tom Hocutt, challenged us to continue our prayer support for the nation of Israel and for the salvation of the Jewish people. We elected a full slate of new associational officers. leaders. and committee members. All that we lack in our organization structure for this year is someone to serve as (a) coordinator for association-wide (s) Senior Adult ministries. In other associational news, on April 15th we handed over the keys to our 1994 Dodge 15-passenger van to Pastor Darrell Alexander and the New Zion mission. The van had developed transmission problems, and the Administrative Team had determined that the cost of rebuilding the transmission was going to be prohibitive. New Zion on the other hand, has need of the van and it will be worth it to them to repair it, so the Administrative

Team recommended the transfer of the title to New Zion Baptist Church. So, the Bethel Baptist Association no longer owns a van, and we have dropped the vehicle from our insurance policy. In the three years that we had the vehicle, it was rarely utilized by anyone other than the New Zion congregation, so we felt this would be the best thing to do with it.

Finally, please be aware that I will be out of the office during the last 2 weeks of May.




