Danny James: Music Gillionville

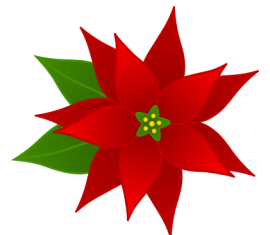
Byron Ednes: Brewton Parker's head of the Bivocational program and a bivo himself.

Our prayer tour is designed to give participants the opportunity to be informed about what happens at the capitol and to pray for those who are making public policy decisions.

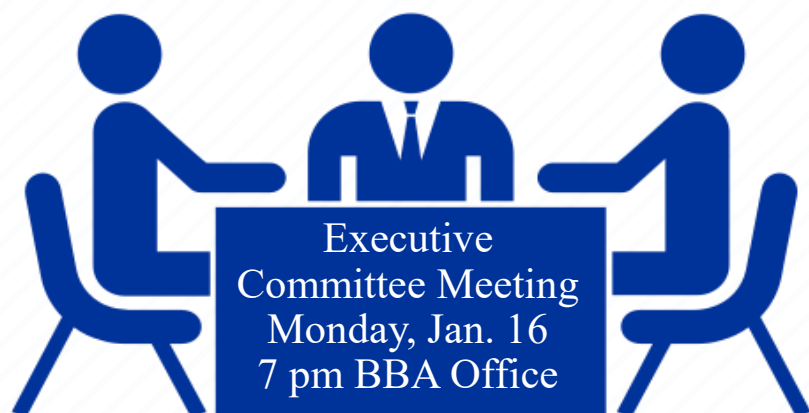
As we tour the capitol, we will stop at various places to pray for God's leadership over those responsible for governing our state.
