Dear Book-Link Friends,

We are in the middle of changes here at the Gregory household. In November Flinn's mother died at the age of 98 in the home which was built as a place for her to be born. We are now in the process of moving from GA to AL to this home where Flinn was raised.

We will be continuing to collect material for Book-Link from our new address (PO box 97, 1305 Lee Street, Rutledge, AL 36071) and to deliver these materials to the home office in Eubank, KY to be sent overseas to our missionaries. You already know, it cost 50 cents a pound for us to send materials in the shipping containers to various countries.

Which brings us to our current problem. We have stored in GA over 15,000 + pounds of materials which we have received without any funds to take them to the home office or to pay for shipping them overseas. Our new home does not have a storage place for us to store these materials and Flinn and I (being seniors on a fixed income) cannot provide the funds needed. Would there be any way you could help with this one time request for shipping funds for these stored materials?

The materials we are currently collecting and sending will not require storing since we no longer accept materials without funding. We need your help so these stored materials will not be wasted.


