
Children's Home Truck Loading

The office will be the designated collection site from October 27 to November 6, then the backpacks will be transported to the Georgia Baptist

Convention in Macon. All backpacks must be packed in uniform size boxes (18x18x16 medium packing boxes) before being dropped off at the office. Please write the number of backpacks in the boxes on the outside of each box. The boxes can be purchased at Lowers, Wal-mart, or Home Depot. If you are filling a single backpack, you can bring it to the office and it will be placed in a box with others. The goal for the association is 400, therefore, if you are taking your backpacks to the convention yourself, please let the Association Office know how many so they can be counted toward our goal.
